

Houston County Sharks Win Back-to-Back Wheelchair Basketball State Championships

The Sharks Won the 2014 AAASP / GHSA's State Basketball Title in Macon; Sharks and Heat Coaches and Team to be honored by the Atlanta Hawks at Game on April 12^{th} .

Atlanta, March 17, 2014 – The American Association of Adapted Sports Programs, Inc. (AAASP) crowned the Houston County Sharks state champions at the 17th Annual AAASP/GHSA Interscholastic Wheelchair Basketball State Championship Game, March 7 in Macon, Georgia. The game was held in conjunction with the Georgia High School Association's State Championships at the Macon Coliseum. The Houston County Sharks defeated the Henry County Hurricanes 38-16 for the title of state Varsity champion, winning back-to-back titles 2013 and 2014. This year's JV title went to the Gwinnett Heat. Teams are comprised of students attending schools within a county school district or cooperating set of districts. The Atlanta Hawks will honor the Varsity and JV State Champions for their outstanding achievements over the next month. First, the Sharks, who hail from Houston County Schools in Warner Robins, will take part in a basketball clinic, with Atlanta Hawks players and coaches this week - on March 20th -at Philips Arena. Then, the Houston County Sharks' Coaching Team (Varsity), as well as the Gwinnett Heat Coaching Team, (Junior Varsity) will be honored as part of the "Be Greater Atlanta" community campaign at the game on April 12th, when the Hawks take on the Miami Heat.

AAASP wheelchair football and GHSA wheelchair track and field events regular season and post-season competition will take place in March, April and May.
